	MACHINE EMBROIDERY – Machine embroidery dominates over other techniques.		
	MIXEDED TECHNIQUES - Quilt incorporates a minimum of 3 techniques in the design and construction.		
	MODERN - The design may include bold or solid colors, high contrast, improvisation, minimalism and asymmetry.		
	PIECED- Piecing dominates over other techniques.		
	WOOL/WOOL APPLIQUE' – The quilt construction may include a combination of cotton or other fabrics And embellishments.
