Quilt Categories

- ART - The quilt represents a recognizable image of a person, place, or thing, e.g., landscape.
- ARTISTIC – An original design using an artistic approach; may include innovative use of material, painted or digital images, abstract design, or wearable art or accessories.
- FOUNDATION PAPER PIECING – Dominates over techniques.
- HAND APPLIQUE’ - Hand applique dominates over other techniques.
- MACHINE APPLIQUE – Machine appliques dominate over other techniques.
- MACHINE EMBROIDERY – Machine embroidery dominates over other techniques.
- MIXEDED TECHNIQUES - Quilt incorporates a minimum of 3 techniques in the design and construction.
- MODERN - The design may include bold or solid colors, high contrast, improvisation, minimalism and asymmetry.
- PIECED– Piecing dominates over other techniques.
- WOOL/WOOL APPLIQUE’ – The quilt construction may include a combination of cotton or other fabrics and embellishments.

All Quilts - Method of Quilting – Select Most Dominant Type

- Hand Quilted Quilted by moving the quilt under a stationary machine.
- Quilted by moving the machine on a track-mounted system
